Tasks for champion to start up

- 1. Once approved, select a day/time for your orientation group training
- 2. Select your helpers. Have them complete the Church Cares helper application form, found on our website. Talk with them about the ministry and interview them, especially if you don't know them well already.
- 3. Send the names/ emails of your helpers to us, info@thechurchcares.com
- 4. We will onboard the helpers with the first training reading, link them to 7cups, and prepare the orientation training for your team.
- 5. Check out our website at www.thechurchcares.com
- 6. Consider how you will likely match up helpers and seekers at your church in the future.
- 7. Plan what ongoing meetings you will want to engage with your helpers in the first 2 months of their Church Cares ministry. Once a month meeting? More frequent?
- 8. Coordinate with us to get the ministry up and running. Complete a memorandum of understanding with us and talk through any questions or issues.
